## Students Satisfaction Survey Report on “Teaching-Learning Process, 2022 – 2023”

The IQAC, under the guidance of Jatindra Rajendra Mahavidyalaya Governing Body, planned to conduct an internal research survey on “Teaching-Learning Process” for the academic year 2022-23, in order to determine the satisfaction level of the students regarding the same and to detect the failures of the administration and the faculty members for the purpose of further improvements. Therefore, the college authority planned to take the sample of 3524 students randomly to be chosen from all the departments for the analysis. The students were provided with a set of 25 questionnaires through offline mode against which they were to mark (✓) their labels of satisfaction such as for offline mode – *excellent*, *very good*, *good*, and *average*. The survey was designed to cover the following topics:

- The first part of the survey is designed for the teaching-learning process within the classroom covering the role of teachers, adaptation of ICT tools, syllabus, and the study resources.
- The second part of the survey dealt with the extracurricular activities the college and the department provide to the students such as internship, student exchange program, field visit opportunities, and future career goals, identification of strength and weaknesses of the students, responsibility and availability of teachers.
- The third section of the survey was based on college administration, facilities of basic facilities like clean lavatory, drinking water, sanitization like.
- The fourth part of the survey was about the information of the library and resources, encouragements to research study.
- And the last part of the survey focused on the environment and the practices of sustainability within the college campus.

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Through this survey the IQAC wanted to know and understand their strengths and weakness in order to improve the teaching-learning process and to rectify the mistakes and weaknesses.

## METHODOLOGY

We have given a set of questionnaires to the sample of 1000 students of Jatindra Rajendra Mahavidyalaya in offline mode, and students were strictly instructed not to submit more than one survey. They were given liberty to choose the mode of participation i.e. offline mode of survey. The list of surveyed students or the sampled students were established in the existence of college admission rolls containing 3524 students and in the rolls of their respective departments. A student satisfaction survey was created to obtain information about *the curricular activities, teachers' role, extracurricular activities, college administration, career guidance and environment consciousness and sustainability of the college campus*. The survey had a variety of questions and statements covering the above-mentioned areas.

## RESULTS

The IQAC of Jatindra Rajendra Mahavidyalaya was well prepared to conduct the survey research on the satisfaction labels of the students who were studying in the college. The college randomly selected 100 offline Students Satisfaction Survey Response sheets of 1000 students were collected and altogether they were analyzed to detect the drawbacks of the college around the pre-determined parameters of the questions and they will be improved from the following academic session i.e. 2023-24.

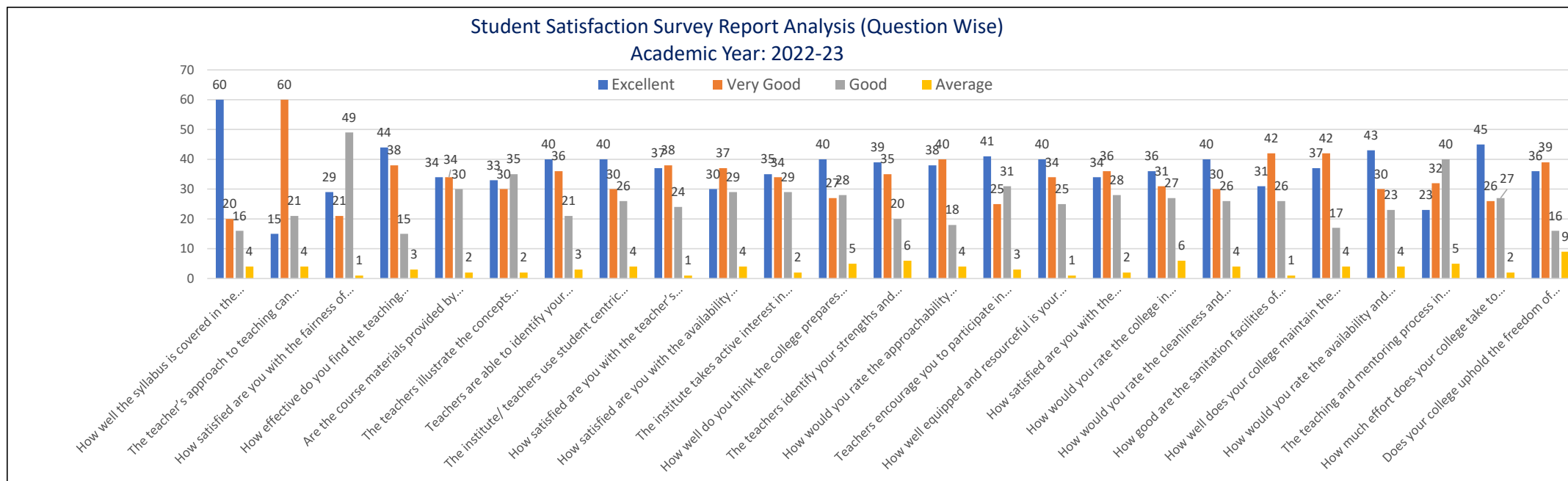

## ANALYSIS OF STUDENT FEEDBACK REPORT USING BAR DIAGRAM



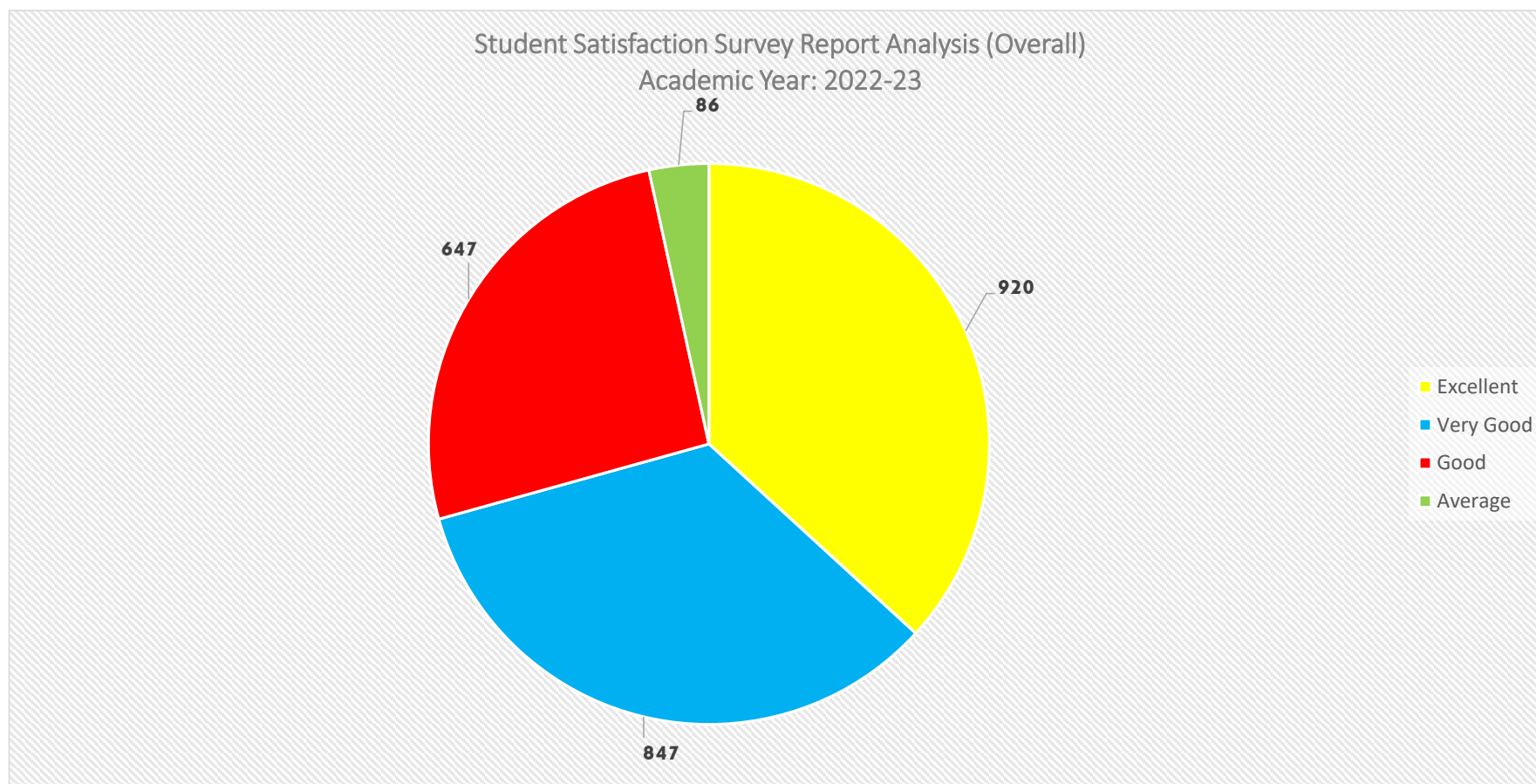
From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that sixty percent (60%) of the students agreed that the syllabus covered in the class and the approach of teaching of the teachers and forty percent (40%) and above students agreed that teaching method, teachers are able to identify the students weakness and overcome from it, Experimental Learning, Participative learning, problem solving method etc, preparation of career goals for the students, cleanliness and campus facility, skill enhancement initiative were excellent; forty percent (40%) and above of them agreed that approachability of teachers, sanitation of the college, maintaining the garden were very good, forty percent (40%) and above students agreed that Teaching and mentoring process, fairness of internal evaluation process were good and only below nine (9%) percent of students agreed that the upholdness of the freedom of speech were average.
